All express mail must be left with no acceptance signature required. Checks returned for insufficient fees will invalidate the entry; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check, money order, or cash, & received prior to the start of judging.

Entries can be made via fax or email. **There is a fee of \$2 per dog entered in this manner.** The signed entry form in its entirety, along with the entry fee check, must be faxed/mailed by 6pm CDT April 11, and the original entry form with check must be received by Saturday April 14. Fax number is 206-222-2830; email is listed above.

Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts, as well as final confirmations, via email. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If receipt of entry notification is desired, a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope must be included with the entry forms.

JUDGE & RUNNING ORDER

Judge for all classes: **Rhonda Crane**, 921 S. 26th St, West Des Moines IA 50265
Order of classes: FAST (Exc/Open/Nov), Standard (Exc/Open/Nov), JWW (Exc/Open/Nov).
Check-in & measuring to begin at 9am. Judging to begin at 10am. Each class To Follow.
Trial will be held concurrently with the Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America trial. Dogs of the two breeds will run together in each class and jump height but will be scored only against dogs of their own breed.

SITE INFORMATION: Ring is 100' x 100', gated, on grass. There is some shade, and canopies/tents are allowed. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs and yourselves. **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the trial with no monies refunded.**

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: If a dog earns an agility title before this event it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice must be sent to the trial secretary **no later than 6pm on Tuesday, April 24**. Email moveups are encouraged - reply to your emailed entry receipt or confirmation. No phone changes will be accepted.

MEASURING: All dogs participating in this trial must have an AKC height card or they will need to be measured prior to running in the trial. A VMO will be in attendance to measure for official height cards. **Copies of height cards DO NOT need to be sent with entries or shown at the trial!** It is the owner's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running. Awards may be cancelled if the dog is not measured before running.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. **Refunds for bitches in season or injured or ill dogs will be made less \$5/entry if requests are submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the day and are accompanied by a veterinarian certification.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all Welsh Springer Spaniels 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. The Club and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles meet specifications as listed in the Agility Regulations. Weave poles are 24" on center. Contact obstacles are rubberized. Electronic timing will be used for all classes.

AWARDS: First through fourth place will receive a placement rosette and a 6 foot slip lead with the WSSCA logo. First placements will also receive a Welshie print. Each qualifying score will receive a dark green qualifying rosette. New titles will receive a New Title rosette. New MACHs and PAXs will receive a commemorative bar, multi-streamer rosette and \$50 gift certificate to Clean Run. Please indicate with your entry if you are close to achieving this title. Qualifying scores required for all awards. Awards must be claimed at the trial. None will be mailed.

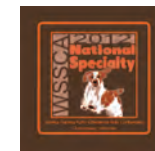

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a **higher height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial **or back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners programSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship to the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In the consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules & regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed on the reverse side of this entry form.
