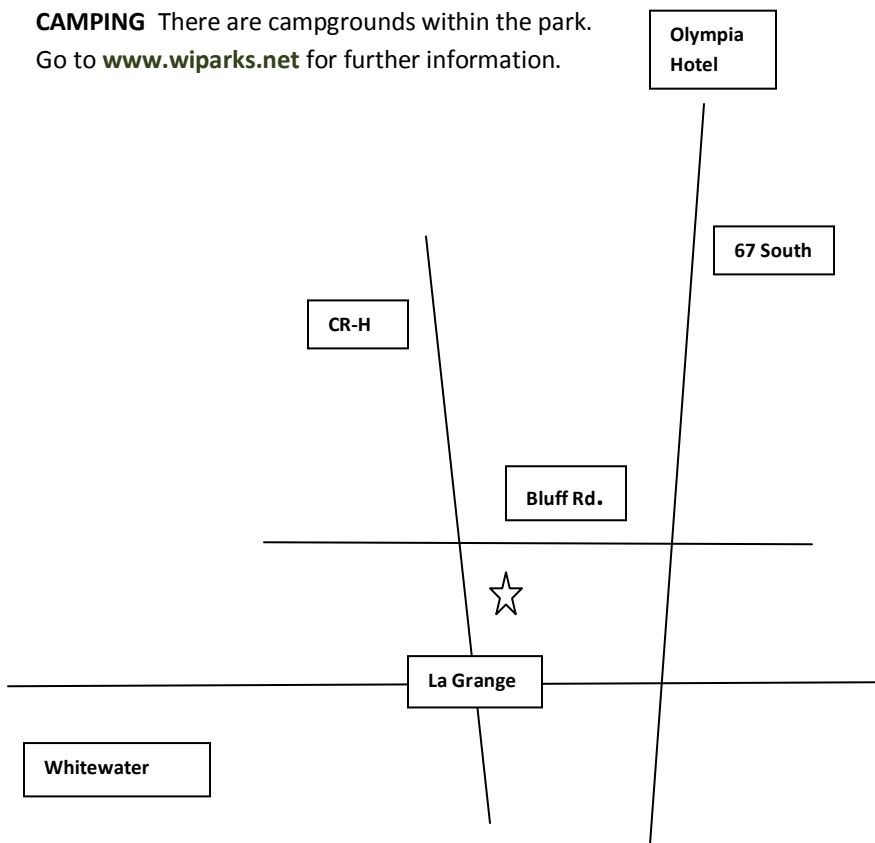


**LOCATION** Nordic Ski and Hiking Trail within The Kettle Moraine State Forest – Southern Unit. N9098 County Road H. The tracking grounds are a part of the Wisconsin State Park System and entrance requires a Wisconsin State Park Annual Sticker (\$25.00 Wisconsin resident, \$35.00 non-resident) or payment of a daily use fee (\$7.00 Wisconsin resident, \$10 non-resident – you might want to have exact change). There is a self-payment station, near the entrances to the park. The rangers do check often!

**DIRECTIONS** From the Olympia Hotel go south on Highway 67 south about 20 miles. Take a right turn on Bluff Road and go about 3 miles. Take a left turn on CR-H. You will see the Nordic Ski and Hiking Trail Head about 1/3 mile south on CR-H. It should be about a 40 minute drive from the hotel (map not to scale). If coming from the south, go north on CR-H out of La Grange, Wisconsin.

**CAMPING** There are campgrounds within the park. Go to [www.wiparks.net](http://www.wiparks.net) for further information.

Per AKC Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 13, other AKC recognized breeds may compete but Welsh Springer Spaniels without tracking titles will be given preference, followed by Welsh Springer Spaniels with tracking titles, then other breeds without tracking titles and finally, other breeds with tracking titles. If the limit for entries in one test is not reached and the limit for entries in the other test has been exceeded, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to the day of plotting, not to exceed the limits set in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the Tracking Regulations.

### ORIGINAL CERTIFICATION MUST ACCOMPANY UNTITLED TD ENTRY

**CLOSING DATE** 5:00pm Wednesday April 11, 2012 at the home of the Test Secretary. Do not send entries by any method requiring a signature of delivery. Faxes, email, credit card, etc. entries will not be accepted. Official entry form with backside agreement must accompany each entry. All cancellations must be made in writing and received prior to the closing date and time.

**ENTRY DRAW** Will be held April 11, 2012 7:00pm at the home of the Test Secretary. Draw order will be acknowledged by email and/or telephone and by mail with draw number and directions to the site. Entry fees will be refunded for a dog withdrawn after the closing date, provided an alternate runs in its place. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing, including dog's name and number. Non-participating alternates' checks will be shredded after the test. Dogs drawn as alternates have the option to withdraw with a full refund, or remain on the alternate list.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** Will be allowed to participate. They will be assigned the last track(s). Please report to the Test Secretary **before** the drawing for track order on the morning of the test. Keep your bitch in your vehicle until time to run her track.

**EMERGENCY INFORMATION** A first aid kit and cell phones to call 911 will be available at the test site.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
